What Jesus Started 1, "My Lord and My God!" John 20:24-28

This week, after a wonderful and enriching Easter weekend with our good friend Geoff Sunstrom, we begin a 4-week series to consider what it is that Jesus started. The Jews expected Messiah to usher in the restoration of Israel as a Temple/State by a violent military/political coup' to defeat and evict the Romans from Israel. Yet Jesus was taken away, tried, beaten, and crucified as a common criminal; to rise on the third day, ultimately to return to the Father from Bethany. In doing so He redefined the Messianic mission. Jesus surrendered His life to remove the wrong so what is right can be restored. Subsequently, the first disciples became known as Apostles, the "sent ones", are sent with the wonderful message of Jesus' resurrection and forgiveness of sin in His name. This proclamation transformed the world, and a movement was born!

The movement became known as Christianity. Over the years, the Church has faced many difficulties, challenges, persecutions, heresies, and hardships to overcome as it carried the movement. And while the church today may not be exactly what Jesus intended, for in some cases the church property becomes a monument to where God once moved, rather than serving the purposes of a movement, and Christians become consumers of religious goods and chattels, rather than participants who invest their lives to share radical grace with others; the Church (the people, not the property) is the closest thing we have, to carry Jesus' message of hope, redemption and transformation into our world. My hope is that as we look at this series, we too will be caught up in Thomas's proclamation to the risen Jesus, "My Lord and My God" and once more be captivated to play our part in the movement that Jesus initiated all those years ago. Then, as Geoff reminded us, it will be as Francis Schaeffer said, "Even when the church is a little of what it should be, young people will come."
