Cultivating Community. Romans 12:9-16

As a church we need to cultivate community, to develop a healthy, robust community that lives right with God, but it takes hard work, and it takes commitment. It means getting along with each other and treating each other with dignity and honour.

Only the Holy Spirit can create real fellowship between believers, but he cultivates it with the choices and the commitments we make. Paul's letter to the romans is a comprehensive explanation of Christian faith and verse 12 is how we should behave like a Christian. It takes both God's power and our effort to produce a loving Christian community. Unfortunately, many people grow up in families with unhealthy relationships, so they lack the relational skills needed for real fellowship. They must be taught how to get along with and relate to others in God's family. Paul wrote in many of his letters on how to live in the family of God. Timothy, Corinthian church, the church in Ephesus. It was a theme that he emphasised.

So as a church I think we do this well, but sometimes we get tired of fake fellowship and we need to look at cultivating a real loving fellowship. Let's dive into Romans 12 this morning and see what tough choices and risks we need to take.
