It is from Biblica having a passage from New Testament, one from Old and one of the psalms. Just look up Biblica .com reading the Bible in a year on your computer.

Last year I downloaded the youversion app on my phone and read by audio Nicky and Pippa Gumbel read the Bible in a year, it was quite good and a good discipline for me.

Don't feel deflated if you miss a day or two, I know we all get busy. But also make it a priority, find a quiet place where you won't be disturbed, at a time where you are your best as well. God wants all of you at this time.
