Easter 2024

I am fascinated by the way middle eastern people have a cultural tradition of feasts and memorial events that shape their cultures. I remember watching the anniversary of the killing of a Shi'ite cleric by Saddam's Royal Guard, 15 years after his demise, with a Muslim cleric friend from Iraq. The people retold the events of his death through exact dramatic enactment. It is a way of preserving oral tradition, guaranteeing important stories are passed on in accurate detail from generation to generation.

Passover is one of those traditions, originally passed down from Moses' retelling of the story of the Hebrews escape from Egypt. It became a feast shared annually, one of the most important of all Israel's feasts. Living this side of the Easter story we see a much more complete picture of God's redemptive plan than the first disciples. They celebrated that Passover with Jesus as what we call "the Last Supper". Their anticipation was still that Jesus was going to throw out the Romans and establish a Davidic Kingdom; remember, Peter cut Malchus's ear off in the garden when Jesus was arrested (John 18:10) What was he thinking? Then they saw Jesus carted off, tried, and killed as a common criminal. I'm sure the last thing they had in mind was that their rabbi was the perfect Passover lamb, sent on God's radical rescue mission for all humankind, without a clue of what was coming on Sunday!

"...as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived"— the things God has prepared for those who love Him" 1 Corinthians 2:9

We are certainly fortunate and blessed to have my good friend Geoff Sunstrom with us this Easter. Geoff brings a wealth of experience, biblical knowledge, and practical wisdom to ministry.

I look forward to hearing my dear mentor break open the most wonderful story this year. I hope you are filled with anticipation too! Please make Geoff welcome among us. Pastor Rhys McFadden
